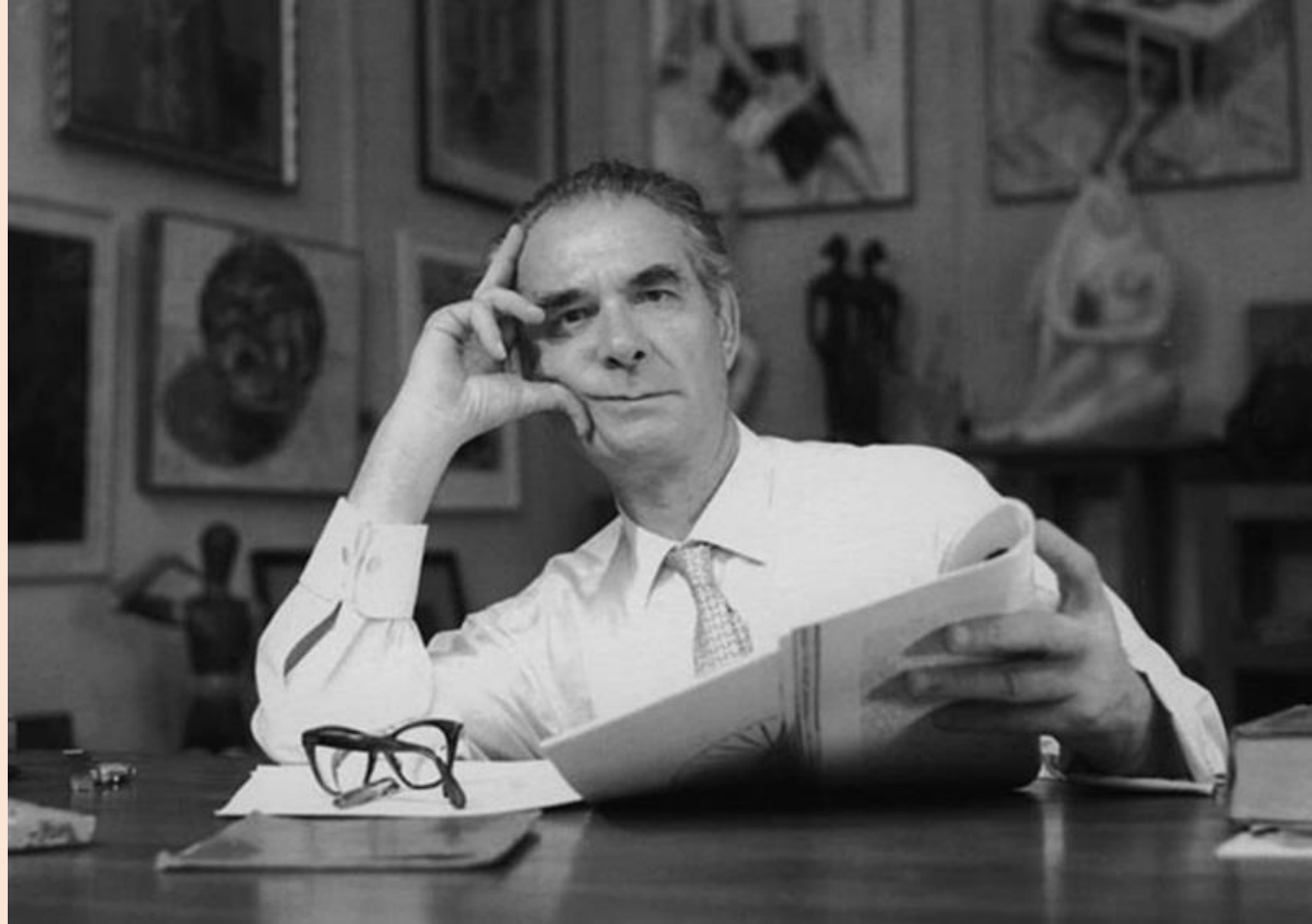

# Graduation Criteria

2. Public defense students' thesis and research.
3. To be eligible to graduate, the research or part of the research must be published or accepted to be published in an academic journal at national or international level in compliance with the announcement of the Higher Education Commission on academic journal consideration criteria for research dissemination or a publication of proceedings from an academic conference or thesis exhibition.



# Graduation Criteria

- **Plan B**

1. Pass all courses and obtain minimum 3.00 out of 4.00 or equivalent, as well as written or oral comprehensive examination.
2. Students' independent study and research defense must be approved by the committee appointed by the Graduate school. The defense will be open to the public. To be eligible to graduate, the research report or part of the research report must be published in any publication that able to be retrieved.
